Everyone wants to help, but not everyone knows what to do.

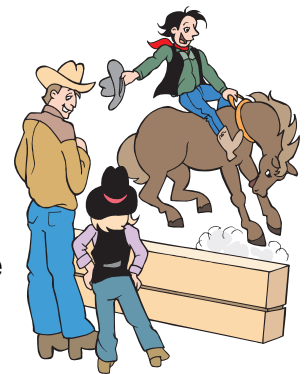
There are many jobs that need filled at the Bartlesville Round-Up Club. Here are a list of a few of them.

- **Concession Stand Workers**
- Someone to **pick up trash** after outside events and playday's.
- **Barrel and Pole Workers.** When a barrel or pole is knocked over you go on out and sit it back up again before the next run.
- **Bathroom Restocking** Check the bathroom to see if we need more toilet paper, paper towels and soap. Ask a BRUC Board Member where supplies are found, we'll be more than happy to help!

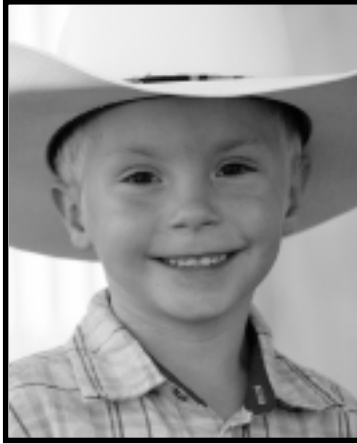

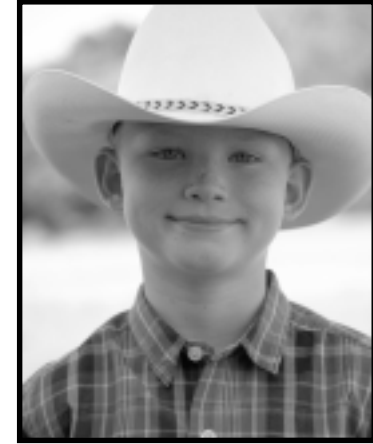
