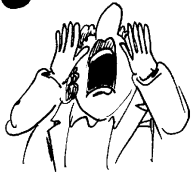


Cavalcade

Green Country Rodeo

In the February BRUC Board Meeting the Board Members reviewed 6 stock contractors bid proposal for the Green Country Rodeo July 31-August 2nd. Co Arena Director, James Lockhart, requested bids from stock contractors listed on the CRRA and ACRA web site. The BRUC Board entertained bids from the following CRRA Stock Contractors. Barnes & Sons and Ringgold submitted written bids. Chigger Valley, G-Money, Lighting Bolt Production, and Bradford Rodeo Company attended the February meeting and presented their bids in person. Jackie Hoffarth was present to represent the CRRA and answer questions we might have about their organization.

Due to the late hour the Board decided to hold a special meeting February 21st to decide on a stock contractor. After much deliberation and several rounds of voting G-Money Rodeo Production was voted to be the stock contractor for the Green Country Rodeo 2008.

G-Money had a affordable bid with the entertainment factor of the rodeo being a prominent selling point of the bid. G-Money states the announcer will enter the arena on horseback through fire and smoke. They also offer exciting crowd participation events such as The Ultimate Mexican Poker Challenge and The Ultimate Ring of Fear! It will be a very exciting 2008 Green Country Rodeo.
