### FUN EVENTS

Horse Required

Scoop Shovel Race - Team Event. One rider dallies up to a scoop shovel and another rides the shovel down the arena.

Coke Race - Rider enters arena rides to oposite end of arena, dismounts horse, takes lid off 12 oz. bottle of coke, takes a drink, replaces lid and mounts horse again to speed back to starting line.

Pick Up Man - Team Event. Rider enters arena and picks up team member standing on a barrel, both race back to starting line.

Goat Tie - 6 and Under - Remove Ribbon from Goat Tail. Fastest time wins

Bronco Stick Horse - All ages - Judged on how well the rider moves and spurs stick horse.

Dummy Roping - All Ages - Who ropes dummy in fastest time wins.

OJRA dates are set tentatively to June 5th & 6th. Clint adjourned meeting.
